

## Food Vendors insurance standards for the Schemitzun Powwow Event:

1. General Liability Insurance, including coverage for product and completed operations, contractual liability, vendors broad form liability of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, and \$1,000,000 in aggregate
2. Recommend all Food Vendors to carry Employer's Liability of not less than:
  - a. Limits of \$100,000 bodily injury by accident – each accident
  - b. Limits of \$500,000 bodily injury by disease – policy limit
  - c. Limits of \$100,000 bodily injury by disease – each employee

Insurance must be provided by an insurance company licensed to do business in the State of Connecticut with a minimum AM Best rating of A VII or Weiss rating B or better. Buyer reserves the right to require additional coverages or higher limits where warranted. Seller shall provide Buyer with a certificate of insurance evidencing Seller's compliance with the foregoing insurance provisions upon request. All policy certificates shall be supplied to MPTN and shall specifically include a brief description of the covered scope of work.

Seller shall provide the MPTN with a certificate of said insurance naming *the "Mashantucket Pequot Gaming Enterprise d/b/a Foxwoods Resort Casino" and "the Mashantucket Pequot Tribal Nation and its Council", and their respective officers, employees and agents as additional insureds* on the General Liability Policy. The General Liability Policy shall include a waiver of subrogation in favor of the additional insureds as respects to the General Liability Insurance, contain a severability of interest clause, and contain conditions requiring insurers to notify additional insureds not less than ten (10) days in advance of cancellation or non-renewal.
